Dear Fellow Republicans;

I hope this letter finds you well. The Executive Committee and I wanted to update you on matters pertaining to the Park County Central Committee.

The covid-19 pandemic has definitely thrown everyone off kilter. As we remember, our last meeting was the County Convention via Zoom. Since then we have been unable to have a meeting given the gathering restrictions put upon the typical places we would usually meet. With those concerns in mind we are trying to think outside of the box and find a location to meet. Our Freedom Celebration was held on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, was well attended despite the weather, and well received by all.

The second part of the State Convention took place in Gillette during the last weekend of June, with 15 delegates from Park County attending. Prior to the Convention four of our delegates participated in committee workshops for two days to draft Platforms, Resolutions, and By-laws and to credential delegates to the Convention. Friday night we attended a delightful dinner sponsored by the Wyoming Congressional Delegation and Governor Gordon. On Saturday we got down to the business of the Party. By the end of the day we were able to complete everything on the agenda. Saturday evening was a wonderful dinner hosted by the Wyoming GOP with Charlie Kirk as the guest speaker. In all, the Convention was a huge success.

Our Lincoln Day Dinner committee has been working on putting on an event, but again, we are faced with covid-19 restrictions. These restrictions limit our ability to have an event which, in the end, will be beneficial to the Party. Estimates for such an event to be profitable would need at least 175-200 attendees. Currently, the largest indoor venue we can use is limited to 78 attendees due to restrictions. Some alternatives are: putting the event off to a future date, having it at an outside venue before fall, or cancelling it for the foreseeable future. Our Executive Committee really doesn't like any of those options and certainly would entertain any ideas from our Party to make this event a reality.

In closing, we appreciate your patience as we navigate the covid-19 restrictions and look forward to continuing our local meetings. Please remember to vote in the Primary Election and be aware of the changes to voting places. If you are unsure of where you will be voting, please contact the County Clerk's Office at 527-8620 to confirm your voting location. Lastly, the Elections office is in dire need of election judges. If you feel up to it and would like to be a part of a process which guarantees our freedom, please contact the Clerk's Office to find out details on how to be an election judge on election day.
